ACADEMICS

IMPORTANT SEMESTER EXAM INFORMATION!



All students will take their exams in their regularly scheduled classroom with their teacher as the proctor. The exam periods are 100 minutes in length. All students will have 90 minutes to complete an exam that was designed to be completed in 60 minutes. The exam schedule is:

Monday, May 19 - A, B, I

Tuesday, May 20 - C, D, E

Wednesday, May 21 - F, G, H

No classes are meeting on these days. Students are not required to attend the scheduled class meeting time unless they are taking an exam.

All students will receive a personalized exam schedule the week of May 12.

If a student has three exams scheduled for one exam day, and he/she would like to reschedule his/her last listed period exam, the student will be asked to complete a Google form request to reschedule the exam to another exam day.

Students who have three exams scheduled for one day have received an email containing a link to this Google form. **This form is due by April 30.** All requests will be reviewed, and an approval email with the rescheduled exam details will be sent by May 9.

ANOTHER FINE ARTS GATHERING!

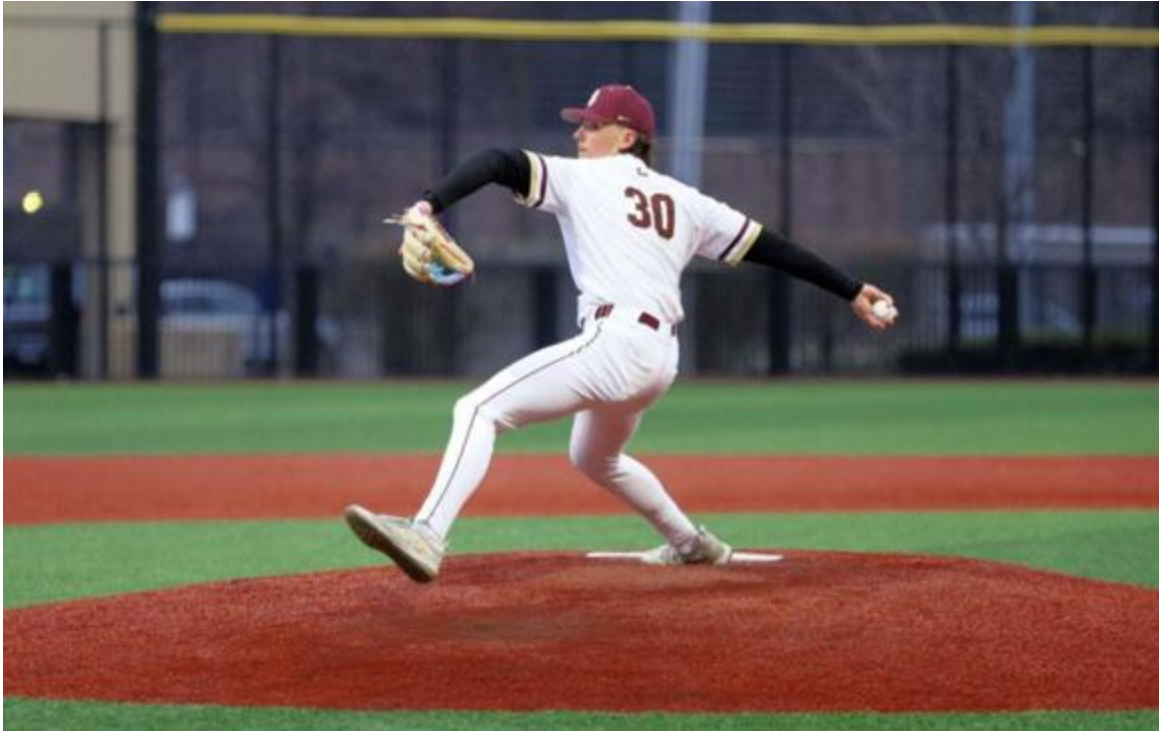



REMEMBERING OUR FRIEND AND SAINT IGNATIUS ALUM, MALIK MURRAY '92

The Funeral Mass for Malik Murray '92 will be at the Church of the Holy Family on **Saturday, May 3 at 11:00 a.m.** There will be a gathering before the Mass in Tully Hall at Saint Ignatius College Prep at 9:00 a.m.

It was with heavy hearts that we shared the news last weekend of Malik's passing. He was a passionate Ignatian. He cultivated the ties he established as a young man at 1076 West Roosevelt Road in ways that served current students and alumni. Malik was a Saint Ignatius Board Member from 2017 through 2023. He was the founding Chair of the School Culture DEI Committee and a founding member of our Tolton Society. He was so proud of his alma mater and of his classmates. When the Wolfpack was part of big projects or events, Malik never failed to send a kind word, or

a "way to go." We will so dearly miss his caring presence and his true understanding of the phrase, "Ignatius begins with 'I' and ends with 'us.'"

PROM

Our goal is to host and have a happy and safe Senior Prom. To that end, seniors please note that coming to prom under the influence of alcohol and drugs, or consumption of alcohol and

drugs at the dance, will lead to significant disciplinary action. That could include not participating in graduation, suspension or even expulsion.

SENIOR ASSASSIN

A gentle reminder that students are strictly prohibited from playing "Senior Assassin" at Saint Ignatius. The game, which is played by seniors across the country, has received significant attention (click [HERE](#) for an example of media coverage) due to the inherent risks of the game. Our greatest concern stems from the possibility that law enforcement could mistake the game for a real threat leading to a confrontation. We strongly discourage students from participating in this tradition - even outside of Saint Ignatius - due to these associated dangers.

SENIOR SKIP DAY

Traditionally, seniors choose a day to skip school as their time here comes to a close. Please note that all attendance policies are still in effect for the skip day:

- Parents are still expected to notify the attendance office.
- Any student who is absent will not be permitted to attend after-school activities, athletics or otherwise.
- Skip days are still included in attendance totals.
- Students with excessive absences should strongly consider NOT participating in senior skip day.

CELEBRATING A SEASON OF GROWTH AND LOOKING TO THE FUTURE!

WolfByte Robotics showcased future growth and resilience during the 2025 FRC Season - Reefscape. This year Wolfbyte competed at St. Louis Regional, placing 29th overall in a competitive field. Building on that experience, WolfByte went on to compete in the Midwest Regional, ranking 27th. Their efforts and strategy earned them a spot in the playoffs as the 2nd pick of the 5th-seeded alliance, marking a strong step forward in alliance play and teamwork. Throughout the season, the team demonstrated perseverance in the face of challenges, learning how to adapt under pressure and refine their technical skills. One of the key takeaways from this year was the importance of computer-aided design (CAD) in streamlining the robot development process. With valuable lessons learned, WolfByte is looking ahead with a renewed focus on utilizing CAD more effectively in future seasons to enhance design precision and overall build efficiency **as they look forward to celebrating 10 Years of WolfByte Robotics next year!**
