**DESIGN, BUILD, TEST**

Now in its 42nd year, the Walsh Construction Bridge Contest stands as one of Saint Ignatius College Prep's longest-running and most meaningful academic traditions - an enduring example of hands-on, real-world learning rooted in Ignatian values. Established in 1983 and modeled after a similar contest at Purdue University, the competition reflects a longstanding partnership with the Walsh family and a deep commitment to mentorship that has shaped generations of future engineers.

This year, the Science Department, alongside engineers from Walsh, tested approximately 140 bridges. Judging was more precise than ever this year - for the first time judges utilized specialized equipment that applied a controlled, increasing force and accurately measured the load at the moment of failure, rather than adding bricks until the bridges broke.

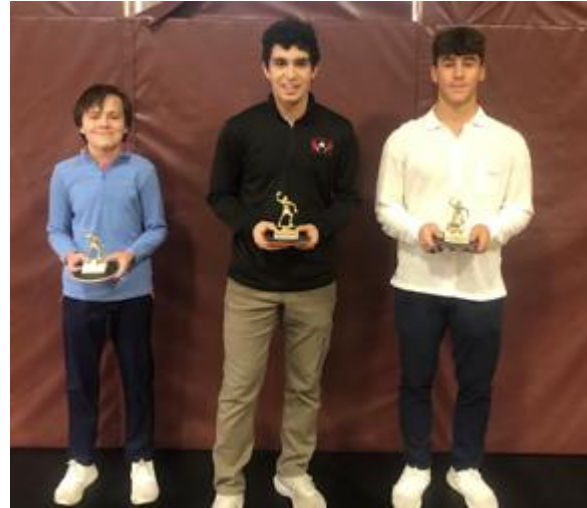
### ***King Kong Ping Pong!***
