### Additional Honors Diploma Criteria - All Years

Four of the 25.5 credits must be taken in junior/senior level honors courses. Students must earn at least a C in one or more AP courses. AP U.S. History taken in sophomore year counts as an honors course. Within the Language, Math, and Science departments, students must take 4 years of two subjects and 3 of the other. A substitution of one credit within these departments may be made with the approval of the Assistant Principal for Academic Programs. Also, to earn an Honors Diploma, a student must have a cumulative GPA at the end of the 8th semester of 3.00 or higher and have no semester failures.
