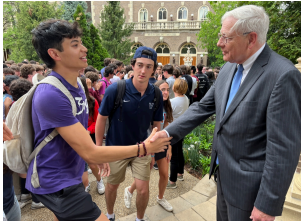

Prom and Post-Prom are this Saturday May 11!

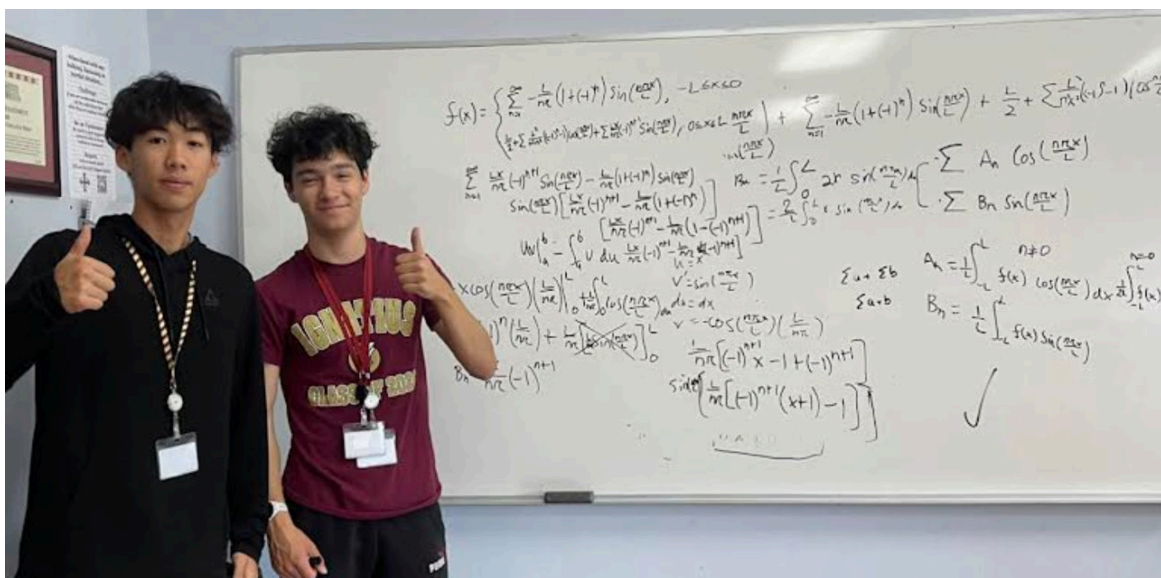
